

Education new-build



UNIVERSITY OF READING, HALLS AND CATERING REDEVELOPMENT

RBC was the Building Control Approved Inspector for the University of Reading's £100 million development designed by architects Stride Treglown Limited. The contractor was Morgan Sindall and Project Manager Parsons Brinkerhoff.

From the project inception RBC was part of the design and construction team creating 1,859 bedrooms for students, built in four to six-storey blocks, including separate buildings for catering, social and laundry facilities.

THE BOLSOVER SCHOOL, DERBYSHIRE

RBC was an integral part of the design and build team creating the new £9 million school which offers state-of-the-art facilities to pupils and the wider community of Bolsover.

Designed by Maber Architects and constructed by lead contractor Bowmer and Kirkland, the school was built as part of Derbyshire County Council's Building Schools for the Future programme.

PIPE PARTRIDGE BUILDING AT LADY MARGARET HALL, OXFORD UNIVERSITY

The Pipe Partridge Building was awarded the Georgian Group Architectural Award for the Best New Building in the Classical Tradition. Designed by architects John Simpson and Partners, it was built by Oxford-based contractor Beard with RBC providing Building Control expertise.

Right from the design stage RBC had to collaborate closely with all stakeholders to assist in the creation of The Pipe Partridge Building. It was strictly designed to classical Georgian style but also had to conform to 21st Century Building Control Standards.





Austin-Smith:Lord

LIFE LONG LEARNING, CHURCHVILLE, PONTYPRIDD

The £30 million PFI project designed by Cardiff based architects Austin Smith Lord was constructed in two phases by Norwest Holst Construction Ltd.

RBC provided the Building Control expertise for a single storey primary school and day nursery, two-storey youth club and sports changing facilities plus a multi-storey secondary school and lifelong learning centre.







LEATHERHEAD TRINITY SCHOOL, SURREY

The project was funded through a Framework Agreement with Surrey County Council and the main contractor was Mansell. Designed by NPS South East, the £7.5 million scheme is a two-storey building to accommodate 390 pupils created to improve social cohesion and integrated learning across Leatherhead.

Sustainability was a key Building Control consideration, with natural ventilation, day lighting and the use of thermal mass heating.
